Dear Candidates,

Congratulations on your success in the CGLE 2022!

It is directed to say that you have been allocated and nominated for appointment to Auditor Grade of CGDA by Staff Selection Commission on the basis of CGLE – 2022. The allocation has been made on the basis of your rank in the merit list, eligibility, preference for services expressed by you and availability of vacancy.

2. Your Document Verification (DV) will be conducted on provisional basis in **Office of PCDA Bengaluru, #107, Lower Agram Road, Agram Post, Victoria Layout, Bengaluru – 560007 on 31/07/2023**. Since the upcoming CGLE 23 Preliminary examination is scheduled to be conducted from 14/07/2023 to 27/07/2023 by SSC, the document verification is held on 31/07/2023. The date and time of appearing for DV may be seen at Annexure -1.

3. Candidates must also bring the following documents (in Original) for verification, and also their self-attested photocopies for submission to this Department on the day of Document Verification in the following order:

a. Matriculation Certificate and Mark sheet as proof of Date of Birth (DOB will be reckoned only with this certificate).

b. Senior Secondary Certificate/Diploma Certificate and Mark Sheet

c. Mark sheets and Graduation certificates issued by the competent University/Institution. (Date of declaration of results of the qualifying examination should be before the cut-off date of submission of application in CGLE – 2022 failing which the certificates will not be accepted as valid proof of possessing the requisite EQ).

d. Community certificate (OBC/SC/ST/EWS) should be in the format prescribed in the Examination Notice. EWS Certificate should be based on the income of Financial Year 2022-

23 (01/04/2022 – 31/03/2023) and valid for the year for 2023-24. It should be confirmed with Annexure – XII of the Notice. Similarly, OBC Certificate would only be considered for the claim and should be in strict conformity with Annexure XI of the examination notice.

e. Certificates in the format prescribed in the Notice regarding category of Person with Disability (PWD).

f. Certificates in the format prescribed in the Notice viz., Discharge Certificate, Service Certificate, etc in support of your claim as Ex-Serviceman.

4. The candidates should also possess at least Two latest photo-bearing identification proof and address proof such as Aadhar Card, Pan card, Driving Licence, Voter card, and any other Identity Card issued by Government Depts/Organisations should be current. Two Passport size photographs are to be brought for use at the document verification.

5. It may also be noted that mere submission of willingness and other documents will not entitle any candidate to claim appointment to the post which will be subject to the fulfilment of stipulated terms and conditions.

6. Documents produced during DV and the eligibility of candidates shall be determined for consideration for appointment based on the information furnished in the attestation form. If found eligible, candidates will be offered appointment to the post of Auditor in CGDA subject to the verification of character and antecedents/claim for EWS/OBC(Non-creamy layer)/SC/ST/PWD status. The formal offer of appointment will be sent to you after completion of the above said formalities.

7. The candidates must note that in case, at any stage, it is found that the candidate has produced a fake certificate or has furnished any false information, he/she shall be liable to be proceeded against, under the relevant rules, leading to such penalty as may be decided, which now extends to the termination of his/her appointment. Such action shall also be without prejudice to any other punitive action as may be attracted in such cases.

8. Wherever, it is found that a candidate who was not qualified or eligible in terms of the recruitment rules etc. for initial recruitment in service or had furnished false information or produced a false certificate in order to secure appointment, he/she should not be discharged or his services should be terminated. If he/she has become a permanent Government servant, an enquiry as prescribed in Rule 14 of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 may be held and if the charges are proved, the Government servant should be removed or dismissed from service. In no circumstances should any other penalty be imposed.

9. The offer of appointment when made, will be provisional for the candidates who have claimed/availed the benefits of any type of reservation for posts and service in terms of the following instructions as may be relevant to them:-

a. EWS Candidates – The appointment is provisional and is subject to the due verification of Income and asset certificate.

b. SC/ST Candidates – The appointment will be provisional and is subject to due verification of SC/ST certificate.

c. OBC Candidates – Only Non-creamy Layer OBC Certificates are entitled to get the benefits of reservations earmarked for Other Backward Classes. The allocation is, therefore, provisional to this extent and is subject to further verification of OBC certificate.

d. PWD Candidates – The appointment will be provisional and subject to due verification of concerned certificate.

e. Relevant Certificate if seeking any age relaxation.

f. No Objection Certificate, in case already employed in Government/Governments undertakings.
